Project 7 - Speeding



Speed measurements at 4 locations in 2007

- Results reported at 2008 Meeting
 - While speed may be excess for conditions few exceed 30m.p.h limit.
 - Hammerwood Road by Leisure Pursuits worst



Still agreed to go ahead with Speedwatch

- 6 people volunteered to be trained with speed “guns”
- Police agreed safe locations in village for measurements
- Dick Tyrrell initiated organising group

Project 9 - Pedestrians



- Investigation of feasibility of footpath to Forest Row
- Requires collaboration with:
 - Mid-Sussex District Council
 - Forest Row Parish Council
 - East Sussex highways dept.
 - Owner of land beside Wall Hill
- **Key issues:** use of private land
road crossings
- Discussions still ongoing
