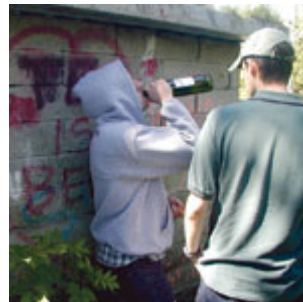


### MINI – MOTOS

Anybody riding one of these vehicles in public must wear a crash helmet, hold a valid driving licence for that class of vehicle and be insured as they fall within the classification of a moped or motorcycle.

The vehicle should be registered, taxed and must comply with the Construction and Use regulations with regard to lighting, brakes and tyres etc.

Anybody caught riding them in any public place or road without any of the above will be prosecuted accordingly and the vehicle maybe seized under the Police Reform Act 2002.
